The Adult Preventive and Chronic Care Flowsheet (DoD form, March 1998), a.k.a. DD 2766, can now be ordered through Navy Supply System/Defense Automated Printing channels. Inquire through your supply department or see the "forms control" person at your command for assistance. The NSN for this standard form is 0102-LF-105-4900. The flowsheet comes in packages of 100 at a cost of \$14.30 each. The form is produced on heavier stock paper, opens up as a folder, and has holed punched in it for placement in the medical record. At this time, orders are limited to 2 packages or 200 flowsheets per requisition. The form may also be reproduced locally, but cost comparison is recommended.
