



## STDPC Membership Matrix October 19, 2001

The Sexually Transmitted Diseases Prevention Committee (STDPC) Charter establishes the STDPC under the auspices of the Prevention, Safety and Health Promotion Council (PSHPC) which is chartered by the Secretary of Defense.

The STDPC Charter and Action Plan was approved by the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness (USD(P&R)) on April 4, 2000. The STDPC Charter delineates the membership and specify its scope of activities. Appointment letters for STDPC member were signed by Lt. General Carlton, PSHPC Chairman, and sent though the appointee's chain of command for endorsement on July 17, 2000.

The STDPC Charter identifies 3 levels of membership: Permanent, Ad Hoc, and other interested parties. A STDPC Membership Matrix is developed to identify current level representation and identify gaps in participation, in accordance with the approved STDPC Charter.
