

**Living Responsibly:
Personal Sexual Responsibility**

“Personal Sexual Responsibility” is a PowerPoint presentation endorsed by the Navy’s “Sexual Health and Responsibility Program” (SHARP). It is designed to be used by chaplains in conjunction with standard health education briefs delivered by medical personnel prior to port calls and/or as part of General Military Training (GMT). This brief is not intended to be used in place of a medical brief but rather to compliment it with a values-based approach to responsible sexuality and STD prevention. The brief is based on the Navy Core Values of Honor, Courage and Commitment, with the addition of Integrity. Chaplains are encouraged to share insights relevant to the brief’s content according to his/her experience and faith perspective. Notes are placed throughout the presentation to expand different points, however a chaplain can add his/her own slides as deemed necessary to accommodate particular groups.
