Correspondence Course Available: *Sexually Transmitted Diseases*



Looking for a self-study option to brush-up on your knowledge of sexually transmitted disease (STD) prevention?

Navy Preventive Medicine Technicians and other Navy people may enroll in the **Army** correspondence course **MD0055, Sexually Transmitted Diseases**.

This 1-volume course covers STD transmission and control, infectious disease characteristics, human anatomy, case management, and the basic information about 11 STDs. Students complete and mail an open-book, 50-question examination included in the volume. There is no fee for military members and employees of the Department of Defense.
