Ready to Use Lecture for Navy Chaplains


“Personal Sexual Responsibility”

SHARP is pleased to announce the availability of a Navy Chaplain’s lecture entitled “**Personal Sexual Responsibility**”. This fully scripted PowerPoint lecture is a values-based approach to responsible sexuality and STD prevention based on Navy Core Values. It is intended for use by chaplains to compliment lectures delivered by health professionals or GMTs. The lecture was developed and approved by the Special Assistant for Pastoral Care - Bureau of Medicine and Surgery (M00G).

Again, this lecture is **not** intended to be used in place of a medical / GMT lecture, but rather to compliment it with a values-based approach to responsible sexuality and STD prevention. SHARP endorses the content of the lecture. We suggest that SHARP instructors invite their local chaplain to speak with them when conducting sexual health education.
