SHARP Training in New Orleans 11-13 March 2003

Naval Medical Ambulatory Care Clinic New Orleans will host SHARP training in March 2003. Training events will include:

Navy and Marine Corps Sexual Health Issues and Efforts (1-hr briefing; 11 Mar). This briefing provides an overview of DoN and local challenges and programs and is reserved for local medical leadership.

Sexual Risk Assessment in the Outpatient Setting (1.5 hr provider lecture; 13 Mar). This lecture introduces, demonstrates and advocates a prevention model that primary care providers may use to conduct brief sexual risk assessments and interventions among their outpatients – even when the chief complaint does not involve sexual health. Continuing education credit is awarded.

HIV-STD Prevention Counseling (2-day course; 11-12 Mar). This course teaches an evidence-based model and skills to reduce risky sexual behavior among patients who have demonstrated increased risk. Continuing education credit is awarded.

Sexual Partner Counseling and Referral Course (5-hr course; 13 Mar). This new course teaches a CDC model and skills to enable health professionals to bring to treatment the sexual partners of patients diagnosed with sexually transmitted infections.
