



SHARP has developed a **voluntary performance evaluation tool** (at http://www-nehc.med.navy.mil/downloads/hp/mtf_sharp_criteria.pdf) for use by medical commands and commands with medical capability.

This evaluation tool measures 10 criteria based on selected national Healthy People 2010 objectives and on supporting objectives established by SHARP. A "Clinician Survey" form is included to assist commands with easy collection of the data.
